

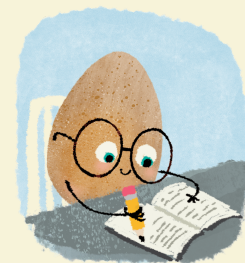

Midday Meal: 11:15 – 11:45 a.m.

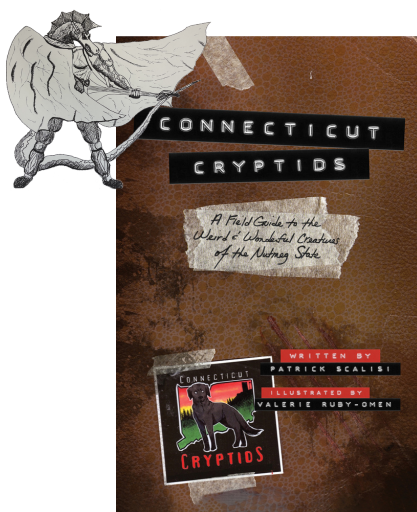
