Foxwoods Resort Casino, Bingo Hall, 350 Trolley Line Blvd, Mashantucket, CT 06338

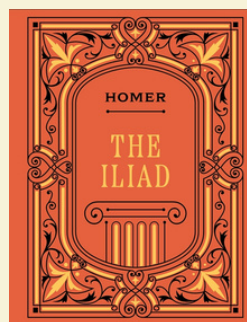
